Dear Parent, Greetings from New Indian Model School, Dubai.

- A play-based, inquiry-driven approach will be adopted, with flexibility for schools to implement varied teaching models suited to both native and non-native Arabic speakers.
- To create an engaging and meaningful learning experience, at least one-third of the instructional time will be dedicated to interactive, culturally relevant activities.
- To support the effective execution of this program, we have partnered with a specialised service provider. A nominal fee of **AED 30** has been included in the overall fee structure to cover this service.
